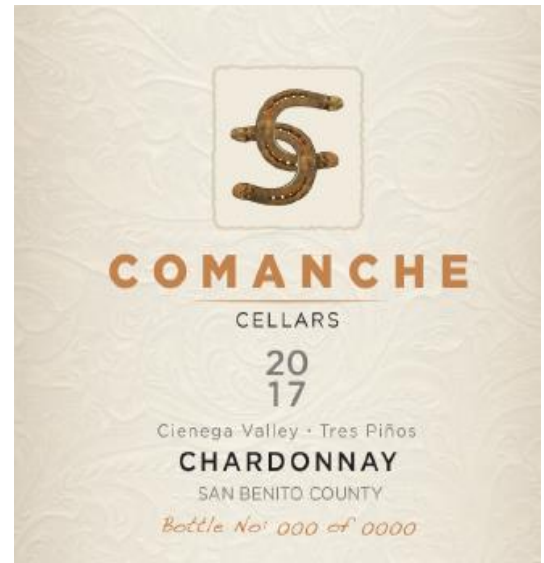

Aromas of quince and honey crisp apples at the end of summer, pound cake with butter pecan ice cream, salt water taffy and a squeeze of lime make this a slice of summer in a hammock, under the apple tree, of course.
