Saveria could easily be mistaken for a French vineyard with its inspired setting - stone buildings and beautifully manicured vines in the Santa Cruz Mountains. Fruit forward entrance of strawberries, blackberries and cranberries, and a finish that recalls dark chocolate truffle infused with orange zest.
