What an intriguing wine, brimming with tantalizing aromas of blackstrap molasses and fresh-baked blueberry pie. It hails from a lovely vineyard on the sunny and warm banks of the Arroyo Seco River, just as it emerges from the Ventana wilderness.

Delectable dense layered flavors of walnut-studded carrot and raisin bread turn meaty and chewy on the mid-palate, with satisfying flavors of grilled prosciutto and figs stuffed with gorgonzola.
