With a tantalizing spiced nose, this Grenache, grown in the warm, sunny region of San Benito County, offers a mouthful of raspberry, Meyer lemon peel and baking spice flavors. It was aged in neutral oak creating a lovely expression of the fruit with a light and long juicy finish.
